Rawan Online School: Enrollment & Admission Criteria

Rawan Online School operates on a Need-Blind admission policy, meaning a student's ability to pay does not impact their application decision. Enrollment is based solely on academic merit, readiness for online learning, and the timely submission of required documents.

I. Required Documentation

Applicants must submit clear, high-resolution digital copies of the following documents through the online application portal:

#	Document	Purpose	Notes on Submission
1.	Latest Results Sheet/Transcript	To assess academic standing and placement level.	Must include grades for the most recent academic year or semester completed.
2.	Tazkira (Taskira) or National Identity Card	To verify the applicant's legal identity, name, and citizenship.	If a student does not possess a Tazkira, a birth certificate or other official national identity document may be accepted temporarily, but a plan to obtain a Tazkira is encouraged.
3.	Recent Student Photograph	For student identification, school records, and virtual ID.	Must be a clear, current, passport-style photo (headshot).

II. Financial and Fee Criteria

Rawan Online School strives to keep education accessible while maintaining the highest operational standards.

A. Tuition Fee

- Fee Amount: 1,000 Afghani (AFN)
- Payment Frequency: The fee is payable bi-monthly (every two calendar months).
- Payment Due Date: Fees are due on the 1st of the month covering the next two months of instruction.

B. Scholarship Eligibility (Need-Blind Policy)

- Inability to Pay: If a student and their family are unable to afford the bi-monthly tuition fee of 1,000 AFN, they must proceed with the Need-Blind Scholarship Program immediately after receiving their admission acceptance.
- Admissions Guarantee: No admitted student will be denied enrollment or continuation of studies purely due to financial need, provided they follow the established Need-Blind Scholarship procedure accurately and submit all required supporting documentation.
- Procedure: Students must follow the step-by-step procedure detailed in the "Need-Blind Scholarship Procedure" document to apply for funding (full or partial). Failure to complete the scholarship application by the deadline will result in the student being liable for the full tuition fee.
